Staff & Councilmember Reports

HAYDEN CENTER

Mathew Mendisco reported for the Hayden Center. Josh Jones and Rachel Wattles are enjoying their kids Christmas Concert at school.

ARTS AND EVENTS

Rachel Wattles, Director Arts and Events: Hayden Center had our first Dance Event; combination of Perry Mansfield and our dance students. Christmas Dance Recital. The Perry Mansfield instructors teach and directed the dance program. Well attended with around 150 people. It went very well. Sign-ups doubled from seeing the recital. It was a forty-five-minute program. Two winter concerts in the planned; one the 29th of January and one in February. Planning a couple of summer concerts. Hayden Center is hosting several Holiday Parties for external organizations. Hayden Merc and Northwest Health Partnership. Rachel is working on Hayden Daze and start working on enhancing the venue. March abatement will begin the second phase and will work well with the outdoor events as the building will not be available. Our renovation for Phase I should be wrapping up at the end of February.

RECREATION

Josh Jones, Director Parks and Recreation: Omnibus Funds 2.86 million will need to be addressed in January. The statistics for the Hayden Center are stable and will continue to grow. We did end up with the climbing gym equipment and some additional gently used equipment.

POLICE

Chief of Police Tuliszewski: Chief wanted to go over some of the statistics. Three quarters of the year we were down two positions or officer availability through November 2020. Impact of the SB 217 and HB 1250 is occurring as anticipated, due to mandates we have lost 20% of the officer's productivity time. The data and numbers on the first chart, assisting other agencies is up from 44 incidents to 53. Sheriff Department, Hayden Police Department and State Patrol are all down and we try to cover for each agency. Airport incidents last year at 13 incidents, this year 27. People are a lot less respectful and a lot more aggressive reflected in disturbances; 46 this year, last year at 28 incidents. Not only are the officers doing a lot of extra stuff, the calls in their very nature are getting more concerning in violence level. Disturbance does not include domestic violence, which takes us to the more disturbing numbers which are sexual assaults from 4 incidents to 13. Finally, was the attempted homicide and a reduction of welfare checks. Very busy year with short staff. Flights started yesterday, hopeful that we can staff with one officer. Plus side is Dana Christensen full time off field training and Mathew Marchbanks graduated from the academy with honors.

PUBLIC WORKS

Bryan Richards, Public Works Director: Discussed the waterline leaks. Sidewalk project submitted to CDOT and should be going to bid in late February. Solar Project finishing up. \$475,000 grant to replace the Poplar Street Bridge. Separate pedestrian bridge is needed as it is dangerous. Manage day by day and move forward.

Community Meetings Summary - narrative

On October 13 - 15, 2021 the Master Plan update team of consultants and planning staff conducted four open houses in North Routt, Hayden, Oak Creek and Steamboat. The objective of the open houses was to gather information from a wide spectrum of the population from all parts of Routt County regarding their priorities and how they envision the future of the County. Gathering this input is fundamental to the Master Plan update; it will ensure that the Plan has broad community support and reflects the values and desires of the citizens of Routt County.

Many of the themes and values that rose to the top through these meetings demonstrate that the existing Master Plan, while old and in need of modernization, remains valid. The residents of Routt County continue to cherish open spaces and support the goal of preserving the rural western character of our landscape. We want to retain our sense of community. The input made clear that residents recognize the opportunities that have come with growth, but do not want growth to take the form of suburban sprawl. At the same time, people understand the costs of growth: the overuse of our recreational areas and trails was one of the biggest concerns expressed. The most frequent complaints were the lack of housing opportunities, the difficulty of transportation, and traffic.

With regard to the unincorporated areas of the County, the comments reflected the importance of preserving and protecting key recreational areas: Buffalo Pass/Dry Creek; the Yampa River; the Flat Tops; Slavonia; California Park; and the Sarvis Creek Wilderness were all mentioned often. There is also a strong desire to protect our agricultural lands and water resources. Many commented on the need for bike lanes on major roads and the extension of the core trail — particularly to the west of Steamboat Springs. There were also many comments on the need for better, easier, and more efficient transportation options between our communities.

The comments regarding the communities of Oak Creek, Yampa and Hayden highlighted the differences between these areas of the County, but certain themes were common to them all: a desire for increased local services, amenities, and community development. Daycare, trails, youth services, shopping choices, and gathering places were often mentioned, along with the need for balanced economic growth and improved infrastructure. The residents of North Routt and South Routt stated that large high-density housing development was not appropriate in those areas. The residents of West Routt and South Routt prioritized local food production.

For the areas in the vicinity of Steamboat Springs there was overwhelming recognition of the need for more and diverse housing opportunities. The general consensus was that growth should be directed to the area west of Steamboat Springs and that the growth in that area should include a full range of services and amenities. The extension of the core trail to Steamboat II, Heritage Park and Silver Spur came through as a top priority.
