**SATURDAY, MAY 14TH**  
**8 A.M. – 3 P.M.**

**IMPORTANT: PAINT AND HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE WILL NOT BE COLLECTED AT DRY CREEK PARK.**

Vehicle oil and antifreeze can be recycled at Steamboat Springs Auto Parts (NAPA) at the Steamboat Springs location.

- Most recycling partners will be accepting checks; however, check the price sheet prior to event to see if you will need cash.
- If you're dropping off trash, tires, electronics, or metal, do not get out of your vehicle at any point. Volunteers will be unloading any items.
- If you're writing a check for electronics or tires, make it out to "Overton Recycling" ahead of time to save time.

#### Safety Tips:

- 5 mph speed limit will be enforced.
- Be mindful of vehicles pulling in and out of parking from recycle partners.
- Please be patient. Everyone at the Drop-Off is trying to do the right thing for our community.
