Hayden Town Council Meeting August 7, 2025

Call to Order/Roll Call

Mayor Banks called the regular meeting of the Hayden Town Council to order at 6:45 p.m. Mayor Banks Offered a moment of Silence Mayor Banks Led the Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Banks, Mayor Pro Tem Gann, Councilmembers Hicks, Haight, and Bell were present. Councilmember, Carlson attended via Zoom. Councilmember Hayden was absent. Also present were Mathew Mendisco Town Manager, Public Works Director Bryan Richards, Andrea Salazar, Finance Director, Chief Scott Scurlock, and Town Clerk Barbara Binetti.

Mayor Banks moved to amend the agenda to have the Proclamations and Presentations be before the Public Comment. Mayor Pro Tem Gann seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Study Session - - Review and Discuss Special District for Dry Creek Village West Metropolitan District 1-3

Spencer Fane LLP presented the project for Dry Creek Village West Metropolitan District 1-3. He explained that this is an infill project for the subdivision that had already been approved previously. He made the proposal of the metropolitan district to provide for constructions, installation, financing, ownership and maintenance of Public improvements. It was a product of 2008 where some of the work was done and some was not. Phase 2 is the focus of this proposal but technically they have to finish building out the infrastructure in phase 2 in order to get to phase 3.

- 4) Eric Owen, 301 Harvest, Superintendent of Hayden Schools. He informed the Council that there are two seats coming available for the School Board this year and that school starts on the 18th.
