NWCOGID RESOLUTION 2025-01

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2025 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE NORTHWEST COLORADO GENERAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, COLORADO FOR THE 2026 BUDGET YEAR

RECITALS

- 1. The Board of Directors of the Northwest Colorado General Improvement District (GID) has adopted the 2026 annual budget in accordance with the State Statute on December 4, 2025.
- 2. The amount of money necessary to balance the 2026 budget for general operating purposes and debt service is \$ 8,517.
- 3. In accordance with the Certification of Values, as determined by the Routt County Assessor, the 2025 assessed valuation for the Town of Hayden is \$118,210.
- 4. A property tax levy of 35 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the GID for the year 2026 will yield \$591.00 to the GID for general operating purposes and \$4,380 for debt service.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HAYDEN TOWN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1.</u> That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses and debt service expenses of the Northwest Colorado General Improvement District, Colorado during the 2026 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 35 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the GID for the year 2026.
- Section 2. The Executive Director and Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Routt County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Northwest Colorado General Improvement District, Colorado as herein above determined and set.
- <u>Section 3.</u> If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

NWCOGID RESOLUTION NO. 2025-02

A RESOLUTION SUMMARIZING EXPENDITURES AND REVENUES FOR THE FUND AND ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE NORTHWEST COLORADO GENERAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (NO. 1-2022) FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY 2026 AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER 2026

RECITALS

- 1. The Board of Directors of the Northwest Colorado General Improvement District (No. 1-2022) (the "District") must adopt an operating budget prior to each fiscal year.
- 2. A proposed budget for fiscal year 2026 was prepared prior to the date hereof and is attached hereto as Appendix A.
- 3. Upon due and proper notice, published or posted in accordance with the law, said proposed budget was open for inspection by the public at a designated place, and a public hearing was held on December 4, 2025, and interested taxpayers were given the opportunity to file or register any objections to said proposed budget.
- 4. The assessed valuation of taxable property for the year 2025 in the District is expected to be certified by the Routt County Assessor in the amount of \$118,215.
- 5. Whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues so that the budget remains in balance as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NORTHWEST COLORADO GENERAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (NO. 1-2022) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the budget as submitted, amended and summarized by fund, hereby is approved and adopted as the budget of the District for the year 2026 subject to final staff changes to be submitted to the Colorado Department of Local Affairs on or before January 31st, 2026.

Section 2. That the budget hereby approved and adopted shall be signed by the President and Secretary of the Board of Directors of the District and made a part of the public records of the District.
